We've been busy this Fall!

Our visionary H&SA Board and many dedicated volunteers have been working tirelessly to continue the ML H&SA's mission to enrich our schools through over 60 programs per year, and celebration, volunteerism, and fun!

Our Wildwood, Briarcliff, and MLHS School Chairs who organize our school volunteers have been busy all fall with Back to School Nights, class parties, library duty, decorating at the schools, Family Fun Nights, Math Nights, staff and teacher appreciation breakfasts, and more!

Our Wildwood Cultural Arts team works with the teachers and administration to develop and produce cultural arts programming that enhance the curriculum.
